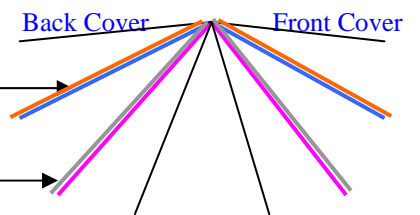

Here is a diagrammatic representation of how "siddur\_spinebind.pdf" is structured:

Page of File	Pages of Siddur	Page of File
	<u>[Back Cover</u> – <u>Front Cover]</u> 56: Aleinu – Warren's letter (inside back cover) (inside front cover)	<= 1

**clarification (by example)**

(( Aleinu: hebrew [p51] –Asher Yatzar : english[p4] ))  
 (( Kaddish: english [p50] –Birchot Hashachar: hebrew [p5]))  
 ((Kaddish: hebrew [p49] –Birchot Hashachar: english [p6]))  
 ((Amida [end]: english [p48] –Bircat HaTorah: hebrew [p7]))



I hope this diagram helps you more than it confuses you!

Above is a diagrammatic representation of the way “Siddur – printing order.doc” is organised.

For example

22 =>                     $\frac{41}{40}$                     –                     $\frac{14}{15}$                     <= 9

The line diagrammatically represents the page itself, with the numbers **on top and on the bottom** of the line representing the **page numbers of the siddur** which should appear on it.

The **numbers on the side** are the **page numbers in the file “siddur\_spinebind.pdf”** where these pages can be found. In the example above, you get the page by printing page 9 and page 22 back to back.

### **IF THE DIAGRAM IS ABSOLUTELY GIBBERISH:**

Or even if it isn't, here are simple instructions to print out a copy of the siddur:

1. print out page 1, and keep it separate (You might want to print it on cardboard, since it will be the cover of the siddur)..
2. Print out pages 2=>15.
3. REVERSE THE ORDER OF THE PAGES,
4. Put the pages back into the printer face down (or face up, depending on how the printer works.)
5. Print pages 16 =>29.
