

Megillat Esther: Repairing Sha'ul's Mistake **Worksheet**

Traditionally, Haman's ancestry is traced back to Amalek. In this lesson we will trace the ancestry of both Haman and Mordechai. By doing so we will see that their battle against Haman, mirrors the battle fought by both their ancestors many centuries previously.

Your objectives for this session are to:

- a) Investigate Mordechai's ancestry.
- b) Investigate Haman's ancestry.
- c) Investigate the battle between Sha'ul and *Amalek*.
- d) Examine the similarities and differences between their battles.

Questions:

6. Using the information you have understood above, explain the conclusions that can be drawn from Mordechai's ancestry.
