The following questions are based on the text of each *perek*. The text can be read in either Hebrew or English.

When you reap the harvest of your land, you should not reap all the way to the edges of your field, or gather the gleanings of your harvest.	r
ָרָ לָא תְעוֹלֵל וּפֶרֶט כַּרְמְךָ לֹא תְלַקֵּט לֶעָנִי וְלַגֵּר תַּעֲזֹב אֹתָם אֲנִי ה' אֱלֹקיכֶם:	וְכַרְמְ
You should not pick your vineyard bare, or gather the fallen fruit of your vineyard; you should leave them for the poor and the stranger: I am 'ה your God.	
Rashi, quoting the Talmud: לא תכלה פאת שדך - You should not wholly reap the corner of your field.	
This means that one must leave פאה (an uncut portion) at the extremity of one's field (cf. <i>Sifra</i> , <i>Kedoshim</i> , Chapter 1:9; Mishna <i>Peah</i> 1:2; <i>Shabbat</i> 23a).	
ולקט קצירך - Neither should you collect the gleanings of your harvest.	
Gleanings are ears that drop from the hand of the harvester during the reaping—one or two at a time, but the do not come under the category of לקט (Mishna <i>Peah</i> 6:5; <i>Sanhedrin</i> 99a).	ree
