



# Dreidel Game Instructions

Each player starts with an equal amount of gelt, coins, or other game pieces.

Players begin by placing one piece in the center to create the "pot."

The youngest player spins first.

Depending on which Hebrew letter the dreidel lands on, players complete one of the following actions:

If the pot becomes empty, each player adds one piece to the pot.

If a player loses all of their game pieces, they are out.

The last remaining player wins that round.




